Notes

Drawing Required

1. The drawing can be in black and white on paper. It should show the size of the advertisement and its position on the land or the building and relationship to adjoining properties and show all existing signs. In case of a sign it should also give the materials to be used, fixing, colours, height above the ground and, where it would project from a building, the amount of projection. The drawing should include the site location plan which needs not to be scale but, have sufficient detail to enable the site to be identified.

Owner's Consent

2. It is a condition of every consent granted by or under the regulations that before the advertisement to which the consent relates is displayed, the permission of the owner of the land or other entitled to grant permission shall be obtained.

Other Consent

3. Consent under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1978 does not relieve the applicant from obtaining any other consents which may necessary, e.g. under the Kingston and St. Andrew Corporation or Parish Councils' Building Act & Regulations made under.

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
