



GET BUILDING APPROVAL BEFORE YOU DO ADDITION OR ERECT ANY FORM OF BUILDING.

The Portmore Municipal Council is advising residents of Portmore that under the Town & Country Planning Act (1957) no additions or erections of building is to be carried out without the permission from the Local Authority (Parish Council/Municipal Council).

All property owners who have done so without permission needs to submit the necessary building plans.

Failure to comply will result in you being liable for prosecution under the **Law**.
