

PARKING SPACE REQUIREMENT

(FROM THE MANUAL FOR DEVELOPMENT)

SINGLE RESIDENCE –	one (1) for every two (2) Bedroom.
APARMENT BUILDING (A) STUDIO UNITS – (B) 1,2 or 3 BEDROOM-	one (1) for every efficiency two (2) for every unit
GUEST HOUSES –	one (1) for every three (3) guest units plus one (1) for each five (5) square meters of public dining room.
HOTELS/RESORTS –	one (1) for every guest unit plus one (1) for each five (5) square meters of public dining room.
CIVIC ADMINISTRATION BUILDINGS, OFFICE BUILDINGS, LIBRARIES, MUSEUMS –	one (1) for every seventy (70) square meters of gross floor area including passages, toilets, circulation spaces etc,
SHOPS, SHOWROOMS, STORES, MARKETS (COMMERCIAL- RETAIL), SHOPPING CENTERS – PLAZAS	one (1) for every fifty (50) square meters of grossfloor area including passages, toilets, circulation spaces etc.
RESTAURANTS –	one (1) for every five (5) square meters of public dining room.
INDUSTRIAL BUILDING (used for manufacturing or storage) -	one (1) for every building up to 460 square meters plus one (1) for each 100 square meters of gross floor area thereafter.
WAREHOUSE –	one (1) for every 100 square meters of gross floor area.
DANCEHALLS, CLUBS, BARS –	one (1) per two (2) square meters of gross floor area.
GAMES BUILDING, PERMANENT EXHIBITION - BUILDING, SKATING RINK	one (1) for each building up to 100 square meters plus one (1) one foe each 10 square meters in excess of 100 square meters.
HOSPITALS -	one (1) foe each 560 square meters.
CLINICS -	three (3) for each practitioner
ASSEMBLY HALLS, AUDITORIUM, CITY/TOWN HALLS CINEMAS, COURT HOUSES, SCHOOLS, COLLEGES, - UNIVERSITIES	one (1) for each 10 seats; if seats are not permanent. One (1) for each 10 square meters of gross floor area.

These are the minimum requirements and the **LOCAL PLANNING AUTHORITY** may raise the standards in relation to the increase of vehicular traffic.
