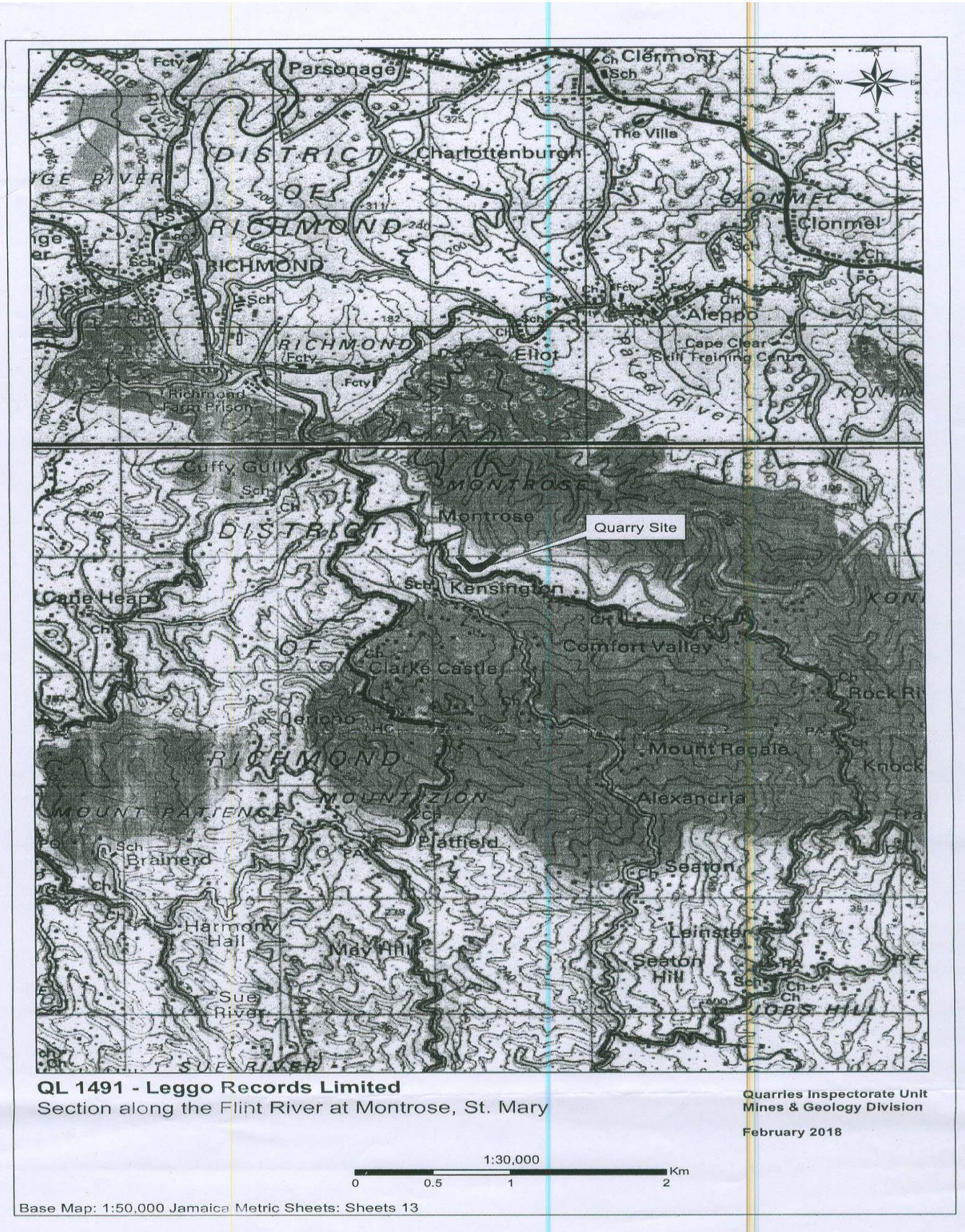

In 2008 the Government of Jamaica (GOJ) prepared an implementation plan to streamline and standardize the Development Approval Review Process within the context of a partnership between Private Sector and GOJ.

The rollout of AMANDA in the Municipal Corporations (MCs) and Commenting Agencies is to create a seamless/continuous electronic processing and management system for Development Applications. Development Applications stand as a key driver of economic growth, and to ensure that the DARP is successful we have to ensure that entities are equipped with the necessary infrastructure to process applications effectively. The improved efficiency envisaged through the upgrade of AMANDA infrastructure, including wide area networks (broadband infrastructure) will enable the approval process to be handled more expeditiously, thereby reducing the time taken for the processing of applications and correspondingly increasing the number of applications processed at any given time.

The Ministry of Local Government and Community Development (MLGCD) along with the National Works Agency (NWA) is collaborating to develop and implement a Metro Ethernet Network that will provide connectivity to the Ministry of Local Government and Community Development, Municipal Corporations (MCs) and the supporting Agencies.

Discussion between MLGCD/NWA has revealed that, works are in progress to connect the following MCs by fiber – St. Catherine, St. Elizabeth, and Westmoreland. Kingston and St. Andrew Municipal Corporation and St. James are already connected by fiber. Works are also in progress to connect Manchester, Trelawny, St. Ann, St. Mary and St. Thomas by Microwave.

We are hoping to complete all these activities by the end of March 2018. Also, please be advised that the NWA team procured wall cabinets, switches and other equipment to help with the smooth transition of this network. The Installation of the 15U wall mount cabinets will commence on Wednesday March 14, 2018. A schedule of the date and time will be forwarded to the MCs.
